Contributor/Administrator Nomination Information

Nominations may be submitted in Word, PDF, PowerPoint, video, or audio format. The goal is to provide a thorough overview of the nominee's contributions to athletics, connection to Norman, and impact on sports programs, organizations, and the community.

Contributors might include but are not limited to:

- Athletic Directors, School Administrators, Sports Commissioners, Officials and Referees, Event Organizers, Sports Medicine Professionals, Facility Developers, Volunteers, Community Leaders, Founders of athletic programs or organizations, Sports Broadcasters, Sports Journalists, Photographers, Videographers, Play-by-Play Announcers, Color Commentators, Sports Editors and Publishers and Media Professionals who have significantly promoted Norman athletics.

The strongest nominations tell a complete story. In addition to listing accomplishments, explain why the nominee's contributions were significant, how they impacted athletics and sports organizations, and how they brought distinction to Norman and the Norman sports community. Whenever possible, support accomplishments with documented records, awards, recognitions, and other verifiable sources.

1. Connection to the Norman Community

Residency & Community Connection Requirement

A nominee must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Norman Residency:** The individual was a resident of Norman during a period of significant athletic achievement, coaching career, or sports-related contribution.
- Post-Collegiate Contribution:** The individual competed/coached/worked at the collegiate level in Norman and subsequently:
 - Lived in Norman for a minimum of five (5) years, or
 - Served as a coach, administrator, official, media member, or sports contributor in Norman, or
 - Made a significant and sustained contribution to the Norman sports community (youth development, program building, civic leadership, philanthropy, etc.).
- Formative Connection:** The individual was born in Norman, raised in Norman, or attended primary or secondary school in Norman and later achieved distinction in sports at the state, national, or international level.
